

GRAVES OF JAMES B. & GURDON H. CAMPBELL

**HEADWATERS AREA OF MISSOURI RIVER,
BROADWATER COUNTY, MONTANA**

NAMES: **JAMES B. CAMPBELL** (Father)
Born Oct. 15, 1799...Died Jan. 3, 1873

GURDON H. CAMPBELL (Son)
Born Nov. 29, 1835...Died Apr. 16, 1877

LOCATION: Northeast quarter of Section 8, Township 2 North,
Range 2 East.

GPS reading of 45° 56' 35.8"
 W 111° 29' 47.9"

The graves lie north of the old Fannie Campbell Sheep Ranch on a ridge overlooking that site. A high voltage power line passes over the top of the graves.

The original headstones, made of white marble and standing about a foot high, are initialed "JBS" and "GJC" respectably. A newer monument (now laying on the ground having been pushed off its base by range cattle) reads on one side, "James B. Campbell, Born Oct. 15, 1799, Died Jan. 3, 1873. Dear is the spot where loved ones sleep." The other side reads, "Gurdon H. Campbell, Born Nov. 1835, Died April 16, 1877, Tho lost to sight; to memory dear."
