The Canton Church was built at the town of Canton, now under Canyon Ferry Lake, in the 1870s. It was moved to higher ground in 1954 and operated as a Catholic mission church until the early 1980s. The church was restored and renovated through the efforts and contributions of local community members and interested parties beginning in 1997. The church now hosts tours along with free musical and historical performances during the summer months.
