

**FAIRVIEW CEMETERY
(LOWER DUCK CREEK)
BROADWATER COUNTY
NEAR TOWNSEND, MONTANA
NOVEMBER 2006**

This cemetery is located north of Townsend, Broadwater County, Montana, Township 8 North, Range 2 East, Section 17. It is three miles west of the highway on the Lower Duck Creek Road.

Thomas J. Keene, 20 year old son of Flavius Keene, died February 19, 1887 and was buried in the Lavinia Chapel cemetery. Frank Keene promised Flavius Keene he would give him a deed for where Tommy was buried and then would not do so. Flavius Keene started the Fairview cemetery.

The Lavinia/Lavina Chapel Cemetery is next to this cemetery.
