Montana Update

As of April 11, 2020, at 11:45 AM, a total 377 individuals have tested positive in Montana with COVID19. Twelve (12) new cases reported in Montana this morning:

3 – Missoula County (29) total

2 – Yellowstone County (57)

2 – Toole County (20)

1 – Cascade County (13)

1 – Gallatin County (135)

1 – Richard County (3)

1 – Roosevelt County (3)

1 – Golden Valley County (1)

- 21 active hospitalizations.
- 46 total Montanans hospitalized.
- Six (6) fatalities have occurred as a result of COVID19.
- A total of 169 Montanans recovered.
