Montana Summary

As of April 19, 2020, at 1:30 AM a total of 433 individuals have tested positive in Montana. No additional deaths reported.

- Seven (7) new cases reported this morning (Sunday):
 - + 3 Missoula County (38) totals
 - + 2 Yellowstone County (72)
 - + 1 Gallatin County (143)
 - + 1 Pondera County (2) (Conrad area)
- 433 total tested-positive since the beginning
- 243 Montanans have recovered
- 190 active cases currently
- 18 currently hospitalized
- 55 total hospitalizations to date
- 10 fatalities to date in Montana

The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) has released [Version 3.0 of the Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers list](#). Version 3.0 provides clarity around a range of positions needed to support the critical infrastructure functions laid out in the original guidance and earlier versions. This version includes a reorganization of the section around Healthcare and Public Health and more detail to clarify essential workers; emphasis for Emergency Medical Services workers; and adds lawyers and legal aid workers.
