Montana Update

- As of April 8, 2020, at 4:45 PM, 331 cases of the Novel Coronavirus have tested positive in Montana, with 31 of those hospitalized.
- Six fatalities have occurred as a result of COVID19.
- A total of 135 Montanans has recovered.

Paid Leave for Many Workers Due to Coronavirus

If you work for a business with less than 500 employees, you may be eligible for paid sick or family leave due to impacts from the coronavirus pandemic. Starting April 1 and through December 31, 2020, you may get:

- Up to two weeks of paid sick leave if you or a family member is quarantined or has symptoms of COVID-19
- Up to an extra 10 weeks of paid family and medical leave if your child's school or daycare provider is closed or unavailable

Businesses will receive funds from the government to cover costs of providing leave. If you own a small business with less than 50 workers, you may not have to provide leave for childcare purposes. <u>Find</u> information for employees and employers about paid leave due to the coronavirus emergency.
