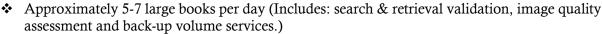


Deed Plant Scanning and Indexing Agreement

- ➤ "Book Scanning" Estimate (1person operation for auto-cropping prep, scanning, image enhancement tasks)
 - ❖ Approximately 400-500 physical pages per hour completing one historical book entirely at a time
 - Severely damaged books impede process speed and thorough output.
- "Indexing"
 - ❖ A separate agreement with Tyler Technologies to export all currently indexed files from DocPro to our portal site.





❖ Every night the images will be uploaded to our Cloud Server, Backed-Up to a Solid State Hard Drive, and upon completion of the project the Clerk & Recorder will receive a Solid State Hard Drive of all of the images for storage at a place of their choosing
